Participation in Chandigarh Science Congress is open to researchers and scientists from industry and academia including faculty, research scholars and undergraduate and postgraduate students.

Abstracts of not more than 200 words, are to be uploaded online, in the provided template as an attachment in Microsoft Word 2007. No other format is acceptable. Title, author name(s) and their affiliations are not the part of the text of the abstract.

Delegates may select an appropriate section as per their subject area. Abstracts should be submitted on or before **February 25, 2017**. The acceptance & information whether oral or poster presentation will be communicated to the corresponding author through e-mail latest by **March 1, 2017**.

Best oral and poster presentations will be awarded in each section.

ORAL PRESENTATION

Oral presentation will be for 8 + 2 minutes for discussion. Oral slots are limited. In case of non- availability, your abstract will be automatically considered for poster presentation.

POSTER PRESENTATION

The space available for each poster would be of 3x4 ft. Each poster would be allotted a unique number/ code and will be displayed on the top of the board on which the poster is to be put, by the organizers.

Top section of the poster should indicate the title, authors and their affiliations and it should be visible from afar.

The contents of the poster may be divided into: Abstract, Introduction, Methodology, Results and Conclusions.

The posters are to be displayed between 2.00 to 5.00 pm on March 10, 2017, unless otherwise conveyed, in respective sections. The authors are expected to be present for evaluation by judges and public interaction.


